Subject: 1st Morgan's road fill site

Good Morning Mr. Wells,

I am hoping to receive a status update regarding the original Morgan's Road fill site. I am also hoping to understand if the GRCA has incorporated an official policy, as CLOCA and KRCA have done, regarding large scale fill operations as we discussed earlier this year. **Yes we have developed one.**

Regarding the first Morgan's road site fill site, I am looking for the following information:

- 1) To date, has the property been revegetated as required by the permit conditions? **Revegetation and buffer planting is slated for this coming Spring.**
- 2) Has the GRCA ensured that that the current topography of the lands reconciles to the agreed upon final grade of the lands and are there any issues in this regard? **The owner is in the process of finding a solution to**

deal with excess material. They first wanted to complete all removals and conduct confirmatory sampling.

3) Have the areas of contamination (level exceeding permit requirements) been removed and confirmatory samples taken and reported? Yes. All have now been confirmed to meet Table 2 criteria.

4) Is GRCA aware the proposed use of the lands? No we are not.

Our citizen's group has been asked to present to the Durham Environmental Advisory Committee on November 21st regarding commercial fill operations and we would like to have up to date and accurate information regarding the sites and issues we will be discussing.

I look forward to you response. Your time and attention are appreciated.
