Deputation to Toronto re Process to Require Notification Regarding Disposal of
Excess Soil from Large Private Redevelopment Projects

I would be pleased if you could include these comments below in your deputation

We note that the professions that the staff report lists as Qualified
Persons does not correspond with our understanding of the definition in
Ont. Reg. 153/04.

In the statement “Opportunities for reusing excess soil in The
Netherlands are different than in Toronto as there are regulations that
govern the management and reuse of contaminated soil” on page 7, we
are unsure of what regulations are being referred to.

As LCCW has been heavily involved with the issue of contaminated soil
and commercial fill operations for the past 4 years, and with this Toronto
process for the past year, we would ask that Lakeridge Citizens for Clean
Water be included in the stakeholder participation proposed in the report.
