Subject: Fill and Site Alteration Activity not in Accordance with the Approved Plans / Agreement (2010)

This Work Order for Site Alteration Work is in addition to the Town's Original Work Order for Site Alteration Work dated **Friday, May 3, 2013**.

Please be advised that by conducting fill and site alteration activity not in accordance with the approved plans / agreement you are in direct contravention of the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville **By-Law 2013-007-RE**, a By-Law regulating fill activity and site alterations.

Section 7.2 of the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville By-Law 2013-007-RE states: If an inspector is satisfied that a person has caused or permitted the performance of a site alteration in contravention of the provisions of this by-law, the inspector may make an order requiring work to be done to correct the contravention.


In order to comply with this Work Order for Site Alteration Work, you are required to complete and / or submit the following:

1. You shall conduct, complete and submit all ground water and well water testing reports as per the agreement, which requires that updated reports be submitted quarterly. Reports have not been provided since December 18, 2013.
2. You shall confirm your intent to restore the 5511 Bloomington Road lands to the approved grades, provide a schedule for the works, and detail how the site is to be brought into compliance with the approved plans. We note the site is still under an order to discontinue importing fill and that the site alteration permit will expire September 20, 2014.
3. You shall complete all of the above no later than **Friday, April 18, 2014**.

We look forward to cooperatively working through these issues with you; however, please be advised that in the event of failure to comply with this Work Order, the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville may proceed with charges and / or remedial work to obtain compliance. Any remedial work conducted on-site is recoverable in the same manner as municipal taxes.
